Principal Crawford went through the General budget explaining Class size Reduction, Administrative, Licensed and Support Staff allocations, supplies, Service Level Agreements, SB178 funds and Title Funds.

General - \$3,318,799

Admin - \$277, 810

Licensed - \$2,113,164

Support Staff - \$ 421,893

CSR - \$832,899

Will be used for additional teachers to meet state class size reduction #s

SB178 - \$342,200

Will be used for 2 Reading Center tutors and 1 Family aide assistant, 2 strategist and prep buy out for PD

3.2 Title 1 budget Planning

\$308,345 allocated - The funds were discussed and the plan was to use on 4 teachers for class size reduction and 57% of a strategist.

### 3.3 SPP

Administration reviewed the plan and made changes to action steps by removing the RAM room. Additions include the partnership with The City of Las Vegas ReInvent. A new climate goal was established by meeting students' needs for completing tasks. The goal was created by looking at the district wide survey. The school is going to continue working toward the NCCAT focus goals.
